4-Man Money Ball Rules

No club restrictions. All clubs allowed.

Each player's tee shot must be used at least once in 3-man scramble format.

All players play from WHITE tees. except age 70+, GOLD tees.

Each player is allowed one mulligan.

The average handicap of the four players x 2, will be the team handicap.

On each team, one player per hole is the designated "money ball" player, and plays alone.

The "money ball" player's score will be counted as half the team's score on every hole.

The other three players on the team contribute the other half of the team score in a scramble format.

[If the golfer who is playing the "money ball" loses it, or takes an unplayable lie, he must add the appropriate penalty stroke, and complete the hole.](#)

The maximum score on a hole is par+3, for the "money ball" player, and for the scramble players.

The "A" player (lowest handicap) will play the "money ball" on holes 10, 14 and 18.

The "B" player will play the "money ball" on holes 11 and 15.

The "C" player will play the "money ball" on holes 12 and 16.

The "D" player will play the "money ball" on holes 13 and 17.
